

PLAYERS INFORMATION SHEET WSF SENIORS CHAMPIONSHIP 2018

WSF have agreed a rate of €85 per night for a single room, €97 per night for a double/twin room and €134 per night for a triple (twin plus one bed) including breakfast and free Wi-Fi. To book a room please confirm your requirements with your National Federation who will complete your reservation.
